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Our policy is to provide safe food.

We commit to including senior management as well as our staff in our responsibility for food safety.

We commit to providing adequate resources to ensure adherence to our policy.

All management and staff play an important role in the production of safe food, and we commit to providing the training required to mitigate risks to food safety.

This policy will be kept up to date and reviewed by senior management at least annually or whenever significant changes occur that might affect food safety.

We commit to ensuring that food safety is implemented and maintained throughout our production processes as indicated in our certification scope. We take into consideration the implementation of good agricultural practices, as well as compliance with the relevant regulatory requirements (prevailing regulations) and the GLOBALG.A.P. Integrated Farm Assurance (IFA) standard, which is based on the Codex Alimentarius HACCP guidelines.

We commit to continuous improvement; to maintaining a positive food safety culture; to taking into consideration communication, training, and staff feedback; and to supporting measurable food safety objectives.
